The Public Note Board

Public Note is looking for a brand-new board. In a team of board members, you will have the opportunity to have a say in the vision and direction of Public Note. Tasks include **recruiting** new authors, **reviewing** articles, **guiding authors** in the process towards publication by editing texts and providing constructive feedback, and **working on the content and design** of Public Note. Next to these general tasks, some board members also have their own specific roles of chair, secretary, treasurer, editor-in-chief and social media manager.

Who we are looking for:

We are primarily looking for **social science PhD and master's students** to join the board, but **third-year Bachelor's students** are also encouraged to apply.

Next to general of board member, there are **five specific positions** in the board:

- Chair: (1) delegating tasks, keeping an overview, and taking on leadership; (2) chairing and preparing meetings; (3) representing the organization to externals.
- Secretary: (1) being the first point of contact for our network, reviewers, and new authors; (2) in charge of internal administration of Public Note.
- **Treasurer**: (1) creating a yearly budget; (2) in charge of contact with our partner organisation, NIG; (3) in charge of the budget and financial expenses all-year round.
- **Editor-in-chief:** (1) Assessing whether submitted articles are suitable. to be published; (2) Overseeing journal content to ensure that publications are of sufficient quality.



• Social media manager: (1) Managing and maintaining Public Note's social media pages (e.g., to post a call for publications or to advertise published editions); (2) Includes simple graphic design and formulating short, catchy texts.

If you are undecided about which of the roles mentioned above would suit you best, we can discuss this during the application process. You can also apply as a general board member.

In general, we are looking for someone who:

- Is enthusiastic and motivated to contribute to the goals of Public Note
- Has strong academic writing skills
- Enjoys working in a team
- Is able to invest around two hours per week into Public Note, while being flexible to sometimes put in a bit more hours and sometimes a bit less.
